

## Shipping/Transport Lithium Battery Statement

Applies to all "SonicWall" brand network security products.

Date: May 1, 2017

This statement is provided to **support a shipper's** requirement to comply with provisions set out in Technical Instruction for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air and 2017 (58<sup>th</sup> Edition) IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations (DGR), and for compliance with any specific freight company requirements.

- SonicWall brand products contains no more than one (1) single button cell Lithium Metal battery (Lithium is less than 1g)
  - Exception ESA 9000 also includes one (1) single cell Lithium Ion battery (more than 2.7Wh but not more than 20Wh). All other instruction remain the same.
- UN# 3091, Packing Instructions 970 Section II, apply;
  - Requirements are met when shipped in original packing for that product;
- To be shipped as not restricted, including by passenger aircraft.
  - The label / marking is not required where packages contain only button cell batteries installed in equipment.
- If package is damaged it cannot be transported any further. Contents must be inspected and repackaged.
