The Network Security Advanced Administration (NSAA) training curriculum will enable students to configure, monitor, manage and optimize the SonicWall Network Security firewall appliances running SonicOS to effectively defend against evolving and emerging network and cyber security threats.

The NSAA course is recommended for networking professionals responsible for the daily operation of one or more security appliances. Upon completion of the course, the students will be able to configure the SonicWall firewall for Secure and Remote Connectivity, Network Optimization, and Advanced Threat Protection.

Once you have completed the NSAA course, you are eligible to take the Certified SonicWall Security Professional (CSSP) exam.

Successful completion of the SonicWall Network Security Administrator (SNSA) certification OR legacy Certified SonicWall Security Administrator (CSSA) certification is required to take the CSSP certification exam.
